

Term 2 Science Projects

You will need to create a project that has to do with the material we are studying during term two. Topics for this project are:

- Physical Properties, Chemical Properties
- Physical Changes, Chemical Changes
- Density
- States of Matter (solid, liquid, gas)
- Mixtures, Solutions, Elements, Compounds
- Parts of an atom

Make a nice poster

- 15 points for correct information
- 10 points for neatness (I'm very particular about neatness and would highly suggest that you use a computer to make your letters and then neatly attach them to a posterboard)
- 5 points for spelling
- Individual or with one partner

Make a book (must have pictures in it)

- ⊙ 10 points for correct information
- ⊙ 10 points for spelling
- ⊙ 10 points for neatness
- ⊙ Individual or with one partner

Make a video (if you need some ideas, see me)

- ⌘ 10 points from the students
- ⌘ 10 points for correct information
- ⌘ 10 points for sound/picture/ease of watching
- ⌘ Minimum length for a 3 person group is 2 minutes (if you have more people in your group add an additional 30 seconds to the length of your video for each additional person)

Make a game (powerpoint or regular)

- 15 points for questions and answers (1/2 point each- need at least 30)
- 5 points for easy to understand rules

Make it Legal

Let us know where you got your information and pictures (pages of books, specific websites-google is not a resource)

Do not copy your information, put it into your own words.

- 5 points for spelling
- 5 points for durability/neatness
- groups of up to 3

Make a powerpoint/slideshow

- 15 points for 15 slides (1 point each)
- 10 points for correct information
- 5 points for spelling
- Groups of up to 3
